

Naadodigal, a blockbuster movie starring Sasikumar and others was directed by him and he also directed it in Telugu as **Shambo Siva Shambo** with Ravi Teja.

He won Vijay Tv Awards Favourite Director for Naadodigal movie.

Again joined hands with Sasikumar in the film "Poraali" and won Vijay Tv award for Best Dialogue Writer and also directed the Kannadam version titled "Yaarey Koogadali" with Puneet Rajkumar.

Nimirndhunil, starring Jeyam Ravi was a dream come true in his directorial venture which received positive reactions for his social responsibility to create a bribe free nation.

Director's Note

"This film is real life. A rollercoaster of reality. Certain events and incidents in the movie were of the actor's real life stories. This movie was shot to save lives and I believe it has".

The unfortunate reality behind today's education systems is an issue far more important than we care to admit. Suicide and education are not two concepts that should coincide.

It's a devastating truth however in India that the number of student suicides are exceeding a number we can't ignore, and the state of Tamil Nadu holds its highest rank of student suicides.

Through further research I discovered that a township called Vellore tops the statistics in its number of student suicides. Destroying adolescent lives in the name of good education? I was saddened by this thought.

4 years ago a girl name Dhairiyalakshmi committed suicide. Despite scoring a 1040 average she chose to end her life. This incident scarred me deeply. After that, every year when the government board exam results are announced, I fear the sight of the news or the headlines of newspapers. However digging further into this issue, I discovered that India stands as the highest rate of student suicides in the world and this was due to our failing education systems and bad school conditions. As a result I realised that parents are also a major contributing factor, if children nowadays feel the security of having their parents support in all situations they will not decide to end their lives. I started questioning myself, why don't parents give their children the confidence that they need? Why do parents take a step back when your child needs you the most? The answer to these questions resulted in this movie entitled "APPA" — "FATHER"

This movie from my perspective was shot in efforts to change these statistics and I believe it has started a small ripple effect. Parents have started opting out of sending their kids to boarding schools in the name of disciplining and encouraging their education from home. Schools from all over Tamil Nadu have taken their school students to the theatres to watch this movie. This movie has become a point of reference in a student, teacher and parent's lives. Changing the society's methods and practices towards the pressures of a good education. It has also created the start of a revolution towards the concept of exams and education in general.

APPA - TAMIL MOVIE SYNOPSIS

Dhayalan & Singaperumal both works as an Engineer in Neyveli Lignite Corporation. Dhayalan wishes to nurture and encourage his son Vetrieswaran's skills and talents meanwhile Singaperumal makes his son Chakravarthy Singaperumal to focus only on his school studies and nothing else. Mayil, Nandhini & Bhanu are friends with both of them. All of them sit for their 10th std exam in which Chakravarthy and Bhanu rank as State toppers.

Singaperumal admits his son in a Residential School where they focus mainly on academics only but Chakravarthy dislikes that School and he feels tortured. Vetri and his friends then hatch up a plan to meet him in his hostel where visiting permission is denied bluntly. They then smuggle Chakravarthy out of his hostel to show him a good day out filled with fun and excitement. The Hostel warden punishes him severely for his actions and he dies as a result. The school authorities cover up the whole incident. Dhayalan exposes the school by lodging an official police complaint. However, Singaperumal looses his son merely due to the pressures of obtaining a perfect education.
